

POPSY POP PROTOCOL

by the server from the window. If people are not following the rules, the server is
required to get out of the vehicle and direct the customers (from a distance) where
they should be stationed to wait.



All Products are to be closed and protected from the environment (sprinkles and other toppings closed in Tupperware, cones in closed bag, all spoons and straws sealed and prepackaged) until needed for use, at which point product must be handled only with a gloved hand. No contact can ever be made with an item inside the truck with an ungloved hand.





• All outdoor touched surfaces must be wiped down with Clorox wipes: Children often touch the item on the menu that they want. When server sees an item touched, they are required to wipe down the surface before serving the next family.



- The servers are required to change their gloves after EACH TRANSACTION. See further detail below:
 - . Server applies a fresh new pair of food handling gloves as customer approaches truck
 - 2. Server delivers customer their ice cream order before handling any money
 - 3. After food is served, server takes money and gives customer any change
 - 4. Server discards the used gloves after handling money and before serving next customer
 - 5. Repeat steps



Thorough hand washing is required every 20 minutes (with warm water and soap for 20 seconds)



 Before employee's work day begins, all employees are required to have their temperature taken with a temperature scanner. Any employee showing any symptoms or high temperature are required to go home. Once testing is available, all employees will be required to be tested regularly for the COVID-19 virus.
